

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CAMPSITE

CAMPING VILLAGE GEVAUDAN AUBRAC

I. – GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Conditions of admission and stay :

To be admitted to enter, settle in or stay at Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac, you must have been authorized by the management or its representative. The latter is required to ensure the proper maintenance and good order of Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac as well as compliance with the application of these internal regulations.

Staying at Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac implies acceptance of the provisions of these regulations and the commitment to comply with them.

No one may elect domicile there.

2. Police formalities :

Minors unaccompanied by their parents will only be admitted with written authorization from the latter.

In application of article R. 611-35 of the code of entry and residence of foreigners and the right of asylum, the manager is required to have the customer of foreign nationality fill out and sign an individual police form upon arrival. It must include in particular:

1° Name and first names;

2° Date and place of birth;

3° Nationality;

4° Usual address.

Children under 15 years of age may appear on the card of one of the parents.

3. Animals:

Dogs and other animals are accepted except for categories 1 and 2. They must be kept on a leash and must never be left free. They must not be left at Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac, even locked up, in the absence of their owners, who are civilly responsible for them.

4. Installation:

The outdoor accommodation and the equipment relating thereto must be installed in the location indicated in accordance with the instructions given by the manager or his representative.

5. Para-hotel services:

a) Reception desk:

Open from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and from 2:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

At the reception desk, you will find all the information on the services of Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac, information on the possibilities of supplies, sports facilities, tourist attractions in the surrounding area and various addresses that may be useful.

A system for collecting and processing complaints is available to customers.

b) Optional sheet and bathroom linen rental service

c) Optional cleaning service:

Cleaning during the stay
Cleaning at the end of the stay

d) Breakfast service, catering service

6. Display:

These internal regulations are displayed at the entrance to Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac and at the reception desk. They are given to each customer who requests them.

For classified campsites, the classification category with the mention tourism or leisure and the number of tourism or leisure pitches are displayed.

The prices of the various services are communicated to customers under the conditions set by order of the Minister responsible for consumption and can be viewed at reception.

7. a) Departure conditions:

Departure from bare pitches: before 2:00 p.m.
Departure from rental accommodation: from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

Customers are invited to notify the reception office of their departure the day before. Customers intending to leave before the reception office opening time must pay for their stay the day before.

b) Arrival conditions:

Arrival of bare pitches: after 2:00 p.m.

Arrival of rental accommodation: from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Any late arrival must be reported before 7:00 p.m. so that we can make the necessary arrangements for your arrival on site.

8. Noise and silence:

Customers are requested to avoid any noise and discussions that could disturb their neighbors.

Sound equipment must be adjusted accordingly. Door and trunk closings must be as discreet as possible.

The manager ensures the peace and quiet of his customers by setting times during which silence must be total, 10:30 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

9. Visitors:

After having been authorized by the management or its representative, visitors may be admitted to the campsite under the responsibility of the campers who receive them.

The customer may receive one or more visitors at reception. The services and facilities of Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac are accessible to visitors.

However, the use of these facilities may be subject to a charge according to a rate that must be displayed at the entrance to Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac and at the reception office.

Access to the swimming pool is prohibited.

Visitors' cars are prohibited in Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac.

10. Traffic and parking of vehicles:

Inside Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac, vehicles must drive at a speed limit of 10 km/h.

Traffic is permitted from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Only vehicles belonging to campers staying there may circulate in the Gévaudan Aubrac Camping Village. Parking is strictly prohibited on the pitches usually occupied by accommodation unless a parking space has been provided for this purpose. Parking must not obstruct traffic or prevent new arrivals from settling in.

11. Maintenance and appearance of the facilities:

Everyone is required to refrain from any action that could harm the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the Gévaudan Aubrac Camping Village and its facilities, particularly the toilets.

It is forbidden to throw waste water on the ground or in the gutters.

Customers must empty waste water in the facilities provided for this purpose.

Household waste, waste of any kind, papers, must be placed in the bin room provided for this purpose.

Washing is strictly prohibited outside of the bins provided for this purpose.

The laundry will be hung out to dry, if necessary, in the communal drying room. However, it is tolerated until 10 am near the accommodation, provided that it is discreet and does not disturb the neighbours. It must never be done from the trees.

Plantings and floral decorations must be respected. It is forbidden to plant nails in trees, cut branches or make plants. It is not permitted to mark out the location of an installation by personal means, nor to dig the ground.

Any repair of damage caused to the vegetation, fences, grounds or facilities of Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac will be the responsibility of the person responsible.

The location that has been used during the stay must be kept in the condition in which the camper found it when entering the premises.

12. Safety

a) Fire:

Open fires (wood, coal, etc.) are strictly prohibited. Stoves must be kept in good working order and must not be used in dangerous conditions. It is mandatory to use the communal barbecues provided.

In the event of a fire, notify management immediately. Fire extinguishers can be used if necessary.

A first aid kit is available at the reception desk.

b) Floods:

The Village Gévaudan Aubrac campsite is classified, by prefectural decree, partly in a flood zone. In the event of flooding, follow the instructions. Consult the evacuation plan for the site now, which is located at the reception and in the toilet blocks.

c) Theft:

The management is responsible for the objects entrusted to it and has a general obligation to monitor the Camping

Village Gévaudan Aubrac. The camper remains responsible for his own installation and must report the presence of any suspicious person to the manager. Customers are invited to take the usual precautions to safeguard their equipment.

13. Games :

No violent or disturbing games can be organized near the facilities.

The meeting room cannot be used for lively games.

Children must always be under the supervision of their parents.

For inflatable structures and the swimming pool, please refer to the rules posted at the reception and near the structures.

Access to the swimming pool

The swimming pool of Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac is open from June 1 to September 30 from 10:00 a.m. to 9:30 p.m.

The management reserves the right to change the hours or close the swimming pool, in particular for technical, hygiene, safety and climatic reasons

Access to the swimming pool is free and is strictly reserved for customers of Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac who must comply with the internal regulations.

Minors must be accompanied by their parents who are solely responsible for their supervision.

14. Dead garage:

No unoccupied equipment may be left on the Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac without the agreement of the management and only in the location indicated. This service may be subject to a charge.

15. Violation of the internal regulations :

In the event that a customer disrupts the stay of other users or does not comply with the provisions of these internal regulations, the management or its representative may orally or in writing, if deemed necessary, formally notify the latter to cease the disturbances.

According to the Public Health Code, if an individual in a state of intoxication behaves strangely, noisy and dangerously for those around him, the customers of Camping Village Gévaudan Aubrac and its staff, he is breaking the law.

The management of the establishment may demand the definitive and sudden departure of the person concerned.

In the event of a serious or repeated violation of the internal regulations and after formal notice by the management to comply with them, the latter may terminate the contract.

In the event of a criminal offense, the management may call on the police.
